CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT

7.35010 BP

Students enrolled in the Metropolitan Community Colleges shall conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the educational purpose of the institution, abide by federal, state, and local law, conform to board policies and district regulations, and demonstrate academic honesty and integrity at all times.

The chancellor shall maintain a code of student conduct regulation describing prohibited conduct, academic dishonesty, and disciplinary actions imposed on a student failing to conform to this code.

According to Section 178.835, R.S.Mo., a student who seriously disrupts the operation of the district, or constitutes a danger to the physical property of the district, or the health and safety of others may be suspended summarily.
