EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

An effective poster presentation should be clear, concise, and visually appealing. The following is a suggested outline that prioritizes readability and impact.

Title

- **Main Title:** Title should be a clear, concise statement summarizing the project. Use a large, bold font.
- **Authors & Affiliations:** The name of the presenter and school.

Project Goal

- Explain the learning objective(s) or opening question to be addressed.
- Provide the necessary context for your project.

Approach

- Describe how you explored the learning objective(s) or opening question.

Findings

- Explain what you found or discovered.
- Highlight key takeaways from your experience.

Impact

- Explain the impact of the project and/or why it is important.
- Clarify who could be affected by this information.
- Suggest possible next steps for the viewers or the project.

Sources & Acknowledgements

- Thank your faculty mentor and anyone else who helped with the project.
- List any external sources used for the project, if needed.
