- Student must have a valid Social Security Number

- Proof of High School Diploma/GED/HiSET
- Student must have a valid government issued photo ID

Must have a current certification as either a Level 1 Medication Aide or a Certified Medication Technician

### Registration Steps:

\*If you are working with an outside funding agency, you must provide an authorization and contact information from the approving agent at the time of registration.

Call (816) 604-4022 to reserve your seat. All applicable information will be emailed to the email address provided.

Tuition of \$200 is due in full at orientation. Please bring all enrollment requirement documentation to orientation. **(We do not accept cash or American Express)**

### Pre-Requisite Clinical Requirements:

- Family Care Safety Registry

**Online registrations are processed same day.** To complete registration, visit <https://health.mo.gov/safety/fcsr/>. You will receive a letter in the mail from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS). *Proof of payment will not be sufficient – you must have the letter from DHSS.*

**If you are unable to register online,** you may print the registry at <https://health.mo.gov/safety/fcsr/pdf/WorkerRegistration.pdf> and mail the completed form. This process will take 6-8 weeks to receive your DHSS letter.

- Online Document Manager (includes background check)
  - Two separate Mantoux Tuberculosis (TB) skin test results taken within the past 12 months – both must be completed within 1-3 weeks of one another.
