Definition: A Displaced homemaker is defined as an individual whose principal job has been homemaking, and/or caregiving, and who has lost his or her main source of income because of divorce, separation, death or disability of a spouse; or long-term family income below poverty level; or loss of eligibility for public assistance; and someone who has not been employed on a full-time basis of forty hours per week for at least three years. Displaced homemakers are generally women, but there are men who fit the definition and have been served with these funds. (If you have been working as a caregiver and dependent on someone else's income for your livelihood, and that income is no longer available to you – you would be eligible to apply).

- Students would need to re-apply and follow these same steps each academic year if they are interested in receiving the grant.
