

MCC Scholarship Application – Step 1

Did you know that you can apply for MCC Scholarships from your MyMCCCKC Student account? Any MCC student can apply for free money! Please read the information below to start your application process. We strongly encourage you to complete the entire process as soon as possible, because the priority deadline for consideration is **April 1** (March 1, 2021 for Henry W. Bloch Scholars Program).

MCC offers many types of scholarships and many of which will require certain credentials, such as a written essay and/or a letter of recommendation from an instructor or counselor.

TIP: Complete your 2021-2022 FAFSA via fafsa.gov and plan to enroll early!

Scholarships entries must be completed by April 1 for consideration. Students who are selected are generally notified and awarded in June.

3. When answering questions, **give yourself every benefit of the doubt**. Each question is allowing for more scholarship applications to apply, and you want every opportunity! **Do not use the back button, because you will be forced to start over**. Make sure that you answer each questions carefully the first time.
 - a. Are you earning a degree or certificate or both? *If you are interested in both, select both!*
 - b. If you think you might transfer to a four-year institution, *select yes!*
 - c. If you have not completed your FAFSA, select yes, *and complete your 2021-22 FAFSA as soon as possible.*
 - d. If you cannot remember your **EFC number, grade point average, and total number of credits taken**, *visit the Student Enrollment Center.*
 - e. If you think you might eventually enroll full time, *select 12 credit hours or more.*
4. Your answers will filter applicable scholarships, **be sure to checkmark every single box and select “Next.”**
