REQUIREMENTS TO TEACH AT METROPOLITAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

INSTRUCTORS OF GENERAL EDUCATION SUBJECTS: For most general education courses, candidates must possess a Master's degree in the discipline or a Master's degree in a related field plus 18 graduate hours in the specific discipline.

INSTRUCTORS OF TECHNICAL AND SKILLED TRAINING PROGRAMS: The requirements for Career and Technical Education (CTE) areas vary from program to program. Typically, candidates must possess at least an Associate Degree in the field, OR a minimum of three years of tested work experience in the field, OR a combination of Education and work experience in the field.

*Due to the variance in credentials needed for each subject/program, interested individuals are encouraged to complete the pre-registration form at the link below so that MCC officials can reach out prior to the event to discuss any questions about the required teaching credentials and individual experience.
