2019 Medical Networks

- **Preferred-Care Blue Network (PCB)** is the network that our plans currently use. It is one of the largest networks that Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas City (Blue KC) offers. **This network gives members more choices in medical providers and facilities.**
- **NEW BlueSelect Plus Network (BSP)** is a new option for MCC plan participants in 2019. This narrow network offers coverage in 5 counties: Johnson and Wyandotte in Kansas and Jackson, Platte, and Clay in Missouri. **It also offers much greater savings for services compared to the Preferred-Care Blue Network.**

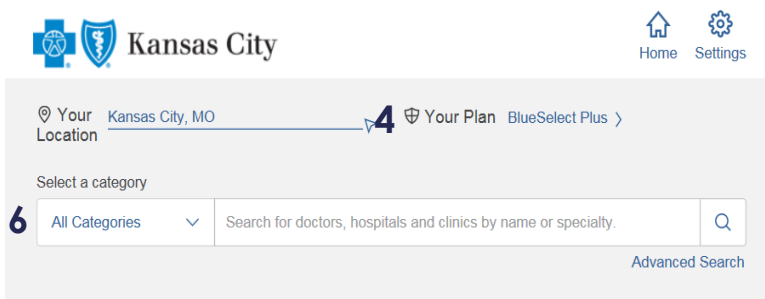
In-Network Hospitals

There are many hospitals in the Greater Kansas City area. While Blue KC contracts with most of these hospitals, not all their networks include every area hospital. The **Preferred-Care Blue Network** offers coverage with the majority of the area hospitals in-network. While the **BlueSelect Plus Network** covers seven area hospitals in-network. The chart to the right shows which of the major hospitals participate in each network. The **Xs** denote that the hospital listed is in that specific network.

Receive the most out of your benefits!

While all MCC plans give you the option of using out-of-network providers, you can save money by using in-network providers because Blue Cross Blue Shield of Kansas City has negotiated significant discounts with them.

Please note: Your out-of-pocket costs are greater in the **BlueSelect Plus** plans when you see *non-network* providers. Be careful to use in-network providers whenever you can, whichever plan you choose.



PROVIDER SEARCH

To find a participating provider before making your enrollment decision follow these steps:

- 1 Go to www.bluekc.com
- 2 Click "Find a Doctor"
- 3 Next, click "Search"
- 4 Before you begin your search, select "Your Plan" under the "All Plans" link at the top of the page
- 5 Then, choose the "**BlueSelect Plus**" or "**Preferred-Care Blue**" medical network
- 6 Now, you can search for a specific provider, specialty, clinic, etc.
- 7 Once located, click on the providers name, if it appears
- 8 Finally, click "Plans Accepted" inside the box with the providers information to verify that they are in the network you identified.

Once you are enrolled and benefits are effective, you can log in to search for a provider. Your network will automatically be selected for you.
