2.15040 BP

Although the community college is primarily a teaching institution, the board will make provision for the encouragement of research by staff members when it contributes to the professional growth of the individual and the mission and goals of the district.

The chancellor may permit the use of district equipment and facilities by those faculty members conducting research on other than district time. Such use of equipment and facilities shall not interfere with their use for instructional purposes, nor may it constitute other than nominal expense to the district.
