TUITION AND FEE WAIVERS FOR CITIZENS 65 OR OLDER

4.10040 BP

In keeping with the role and function of the comprehensive community college as a public institution, those individuals who reside within the district aged sixty-five or older shall be eligible for fee waivers at district campuses as follows:

- (1) Free entry on a general admission basis shall be provided to such public events as musical performances, dramatic presentations, and athletic contests.
- (2) All fees shall be waived for those who wish to participate in college credit classes and community services programs and activities on a space available basis when a class or other activity has achieved the required minimum enrollment. Fee-paying students shall at all times have priority of enrollment in a course.
- (3) Books, supplies and laboratory or special fees for such programs shall be the responsibility of the senior citizen.

The chancellor is authorized to establish appropriate procedures to implement this policy, including those regarding admission and registration.
