In recognition of the increasingly diverse student population entering district community colleges, as well as the promise of equal educational opportunity afforded by community colleges in general, it is necessary that new approaches to the teaching-learning process be implemented. More than ever before, opportunities are needed for faculty members to keep abreast of their fields, to undertake research, to acquaint themselves with new media, and to design and carry out innovations and experiments in the classroom.

Recognizing the importance of maintaining utmost quality of instruction, as well as a variety of instructional approaches necessary to educate a diverse student clientele, the board authorizes the chancellor to administer a program of educational development grants. The educational development grants program shall provide full-time faculty in the district, either singly or through joint cooperative efforts, an opportunity to engage in innovative approaches to the teaching-learning process and to further their professional growth.
