NAME OF POLICY Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

PURPOSE Metropolitan Community College (MCC) protects persons with a disability or limitation, those who have a history of record of such impairment, and those who are regarded as having such impairment.

The Board is committed to providing an inclusive and welcoming environment for all members of our community, with access to courses, programs, employment, services, and extracurricular activities free from discrimination and harassment. MCC complies with federal and state laws concerning persons with disabilities and acts in accordance with regulations and guidance issued by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

APPLICABILITY This policy applies to all students and employees of Metropolitan Community College.

POLICY
MODIFICATION This policy may be modified or revoked at any time at the sole direction of MCC's Board of Trustees.

DELEGATION OF
AUTHORITY Within the framework of policies adopted by the Board, the Chancellor shall exercise discretionary authority in carrying out responsibilities of the position and shall formulate and promulgate regulations and procedures designated to implement Board policies.
