## **Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Construction Management – Advising Guide**

This program follows the ACCE guideline for a construction management program. We offer the first two years of a typical 4-year accredited program. Upon completion of the AAS degree, students may transfer to a 4-year program (such as the University of Central Missouri- where we have a written transfer document) or go directly into the industry.
