

Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Physical Therapist Assistant – Full-Time Advising Guide

Physical therapist assistants (PTA) provide direct client care under the supervision of a physical therapist and help improve mobility, relieve pain and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities due to injury or disease. PTAs work in hospitals, outpatient clinics, sports clinics, rehabilitation centers, extended-care facilities and schools. This program leads to an Associate in Applied Science degree and prepares students to assist physical therapists in treating patients with physical disabilities in various health care settings.
