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UCM DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS PROGRAM

- Minimum hours: 132.5-139.5
- Minimum of 30 hours upper level credit (courses numbered 3000 and above). Courses taken at MCC do not count toward the upper-level requirement though they sometimes may be articulated as upper level classes.
- Minimum of 12 upper level credit hours in major
- Minor requirement: No
- Modern language requirement: No

BME Instrumental students are expected to be in a major large instrumental ensemble during every semester up to their student teaching semester, with a minimum of seven (7) separate semesters to include:

Woodwind, Brass & Percussion Students:

3 semester hours in MUS 1005

4 combined semester hours in MUS 1010, MUS 4010, MUS 1081, MUS 4081 (up to 2 total semester hours of MUS 1081 & MUS 4081, may be applied toward degree)

String Students:

6 semester hours in MUS 4025 and 1 semester hr in MUS 1097

Keyboard & Guitar Majors must choose band or orchestra as their major large ensemble, Guitar majors may apply up to two (2) semester hours in MUS 4088 toward their major large ensemble requirements.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR A DEGREE AT UCM

- 30 credit hours must be completed at UCM
- 20 upper level hours must be completed at UCM
- 15 credit hours in the major must be from UCM
- 9 upper level hours in the major must be completed at UCM
- The last 12 credit hours must be earned from UCM

If pursuing a minor, a minimum of 9 hours in the minor must be completed at UCM. There must also be at least one upper level hour completed at UCM.

TRANSFER WORK

Arrange for all transfer work to be posted at UCM at the time of application. An official transcript must be received at UCM directly from each school attended. - Education students must maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA and a 3.0 major GPA.
- Students finishing their A.A. should plan to complete their DESE Educator Profile and their Fingerprinting/Background Check by the time they start classes at UCM. The background check must be completed through the 3M/Cogent company and posted to the student's DESE profile.
