

LPN-ADN BRIDGE NURSING REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

Deadline to meet all the February application period requirements for summer semester is **January 31**.

Deadline to meet all the May application period requirements for fall semester is **April 30**.

Note: This includes students with degrees and previous college course work.

The following six (6) items must be completed and satisfied by the deadlines to be considered:

1. **Apply to MCC.** Fill out the general MCC application at www.mcckc.edu/apply-now.
2. **Submit all non-MCCKC official transcripts.** Send official transcripts from all institutions where you have earned college credits to: MCC Student Data Center, 3200 Broadway, Kansas City, MO 64111 OR electronically at transcripts@mcckc.edu.
3. **Take Accuplacer test regardless of previous college course work, there are no exceptions** (ACT/SAT scores will not be accepted). **Note: Failure to take all three sections of the Accuplacer by the deadlines will result in the application being removed from the applicant pool.** Test scores must be less than three (3) years old, and must meet or exceed the required scores in all three sections; Algebra, Reading, and Writing. All required scores must be obtained on either a first or second attempt when taking the test. Failure to meet the required scores on the second attempt will require the student to take the indicated required classes. Students will not be eligible to apply until the required course(s) listed (see table below) have been completed with a grade letter of "C" or higher. These are the required scores and classes for each section: **(Page # 6 contains additional information).**

4. **Completion of prerequisite courses with a minimum 3.0 GPA.** **Note: "B" letter grades or higher is ideal to reach the minimum 3.0 required GPA (AP, IB or CLEP credit will be counted as "C" letter grade).** The following must be completed with a grade letter of "C" or higher:

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5. **Take the ATI TEAS exam.** Note: Failure to meet the required score on the second attempt will make you ineligible to be considered for the program for lifetime. The ATI TEAS exam must be taken by the deadline, and a minimum total adjusted score of 60.0% must be obtained on either a first or second attempt in taking the exam. For study materials and register visit www.atitesting.com. (Page # 9 contains additional information).
6. **Health Care Verification Form.** All applicants must have at least six (6) months of working experience as a LPN within one year by the application deadline (The form is located on page #5).

Ranking Points

All applicants will be selected based on ranking points. A maximum of seven (7) possible ranking points can be obtained. Here is the example:

- **Prerequisite GPA:** Up to a maximum of four (4) points based on prerequisite courses.
- **PN MCC graduates:** Will received one (1) point for completing our PN certificate.
- **ATI TEAS exam scores:** One (1) point for scores in the range from 68% to 77%. Two (2) points for scores in the range from 78% and higher.

Application Process

To make sure you are ready to apply, please review the **Requirements Evaluation Checklist** located on page #3. The following four (4) steps must be completed:

1. Applicants must submit the online application through the link provided under "Apply" on our LPN to ADN Bridge webpage at www.mcckc.edu/programs/lpntoadnbridge.
 - **Note:** Part of the online application is to provide three (3) professional references. Each of the references will receive an e-mail with a survey which will need to be filled out and submitted by the reference by the end of the application period.
2. Attached your **ATI TEAS** score to the online application before submitting.
 - **Note:** The attachment must show all attempts.
3. Attached a copy of your **LPN License** to the online application before submitting.
4. Attached a copy of the **Health Care Verification Form** before submitting.
 - **Note:** The form is located on page #5.

Admission criteria to the program are subject to change without notice. If changes are made to the admission criteria, the applicant will need to meet all requirements that are in effect at the time of application. Successful completion of the requirements necessary for admission to the program does not guarantee acceptance to the program.

Automatic disqualification. The following will result in the application being removed from the applicant pool (no exceptions):

- Previous dismissal from MCC's nursing program.
- Not a current or not taken *Accuplacer* test.
- Completed the *Accuplacer* test during the application period.
- Not meeting the required *Accuplacer* scores on the second attempt and/or not completed the required math, writing, or reading course(s) with a grade letter of "C" or higher.
- Completed the ATI TEAS exam during the application period.
- Not meeting the required ATI TEAS exam score on the second attempt.
- Not attaching the ATI TEAS exam score and/or not showing all attempts.
- Not attaching the **Health Care Experience Verification Form** to the online application and/or completed during the application period.
- Not attaching current **LPN License** to the online application.
- Not meeting the minimum 3.0 GPA from **Chem 105, Biol 109 or Biol 110 & Biol 210, Biol 208, Psyc 140, and Psyc 243.**
- Science prerequisites are over 6 (six) years old by the deadline. **Chem 105, Biol 109 or Biol 110 & Biol 210, and Biol 208.** Note: *Psyc 140 & Psyc 243* do not expire.
- Three (3) attempts or more with letter grades of all prerequisites in the last six (6) years. **Chem 105, Biol 109, or Biol 110/210, Biol 208, Psyc 140, and Psyc 243.**
- Not submitting official transcripts from all previous institutions where you have earned college credits by the deadline.

Once accepted into the nursing program, students will attend a mandatory meeting(s) to discuss the following next steps and the required information below:

- Health records
- Certified Profile
- Physical exam
- Immunizations for: chicken pox, measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, influenza, hepatitis B (waiver accepted for Hepatitis B immunization)
- Recent photo on file
- CPR training
- Family Care Safety Registry
- Drug screen to be done at the site required by MCC. A positive screen may result in further requirements and a delayed entry into the program
- Reliable transportation: Assignments to clinical sites are done on a random basis. Many sites are not accessible by public transportation. **Note:** Clinical sites are within the 60 mile radius of MCC-Penn Valley.
- Work schedule that is flexible to accommodate class and clinical requirements. **Note:** Clinical schedules are not typically available until close to the start of the semester.

ATI TEAS Exam must be taken by the following deadlines (no exceptions):

- LPN to ADN Bridge Nursing Program: January 31 or April 30. (Strongly recommend to take it prior to the deadline)**
- 1. Go to atitesting.com and create an account if you do not already have one.**
- 2. Select the red “TEAS” button on the MCC nursing pages or go to ATI’s homepage or online store. MCC-Penn Valley test dates are listed if you go to ATI from the nursing pages. If you go straight to the ATI homepage, you have other location choices for testing besides MCC-Penn Valley. Payment of \$102 is required upon registration.**
- 3. The MCC-Penn Valley Testing Center is located on the ‘0’ level of the Humanities building in room HU009**
- 4. MCC-Penn Valley Testing Center administers the test on most Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays.**

Mathematics	54 minutes	Numbers, algebra and data interpretation and measurement

English	28 minutes	Conventions of standard English, knowledge of language and vocabulary acquisition

1. Your scores will be available immediately after testing, and you may print the scores, if desired. You can also access your scores from home at atitesting.com, using your username and password.
