

**EDUCATIONAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
OTTAWA UNIVERSITY
AND
METROPOLITAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

Addendum

In support of the goals shared by Metropolitan Community College "MCC" and Ottawa University ("Ottawa") to increase both associate's and bachelor's degree graduation rates, and to make the achievement of these degrees more affordable, the parties agree as follows:

Scholarship and Supplemental Details:

1. Effective from the Ottawa term beginning June 25, 2018 Ottawa will offer a reduction in tuition to any MCC associate degree graduate who transfers to complete a baccalaureate degree program at Ottawa University. The transfer advantage program will reduce the per credit hour tuition paid by the new student to an effective rate \$175 below the posted rate for standard Bachelor's level coursework (\$324 per credit hour for the 2018-2019 fiscal year). The reduction in tuition is limited to one baccalaureate degree per student, and to coursework which applies to the student's program of choice. Coursework may be completed online or on campus at Ottawa University's adult locations as course offerings are available. Students may begin in any term throughout the academic year. The student is eligible to receive the reduced tuition rate for two (2) years from the start of their first course, or until completion of the baccalaureate degree – whichever occurs first.

MCC Support for Students Transferring to Ottawa:

2. As part of this agreement, MCC agrees to assist in informing students of this tuition incentive benefit using existing channels and resources, as well as others upon which the parties may mutually agree. Ottawa invites MCC to participate in joint announcements of this program, and in lending the use of its name and logos for this purpose in promotional materials, mailing pieces, digital media, or other items by mutual agreement. It is understood that either party using the other's name and logos will obtain the approval of the other party prior to its distribution. Each party agrees to acknowledge and recognize the agreement on each institution's website and via other marketing and publicity methods. MCC agrees to provide Ottawa with access to graduate directory contact information (including phone numbers, emails and mailing addresses), in compliance with FERPA regulations, to enable Ottawa to contact potential program applicants.

Evaluation:

3. Both parties agree to exchange data and documentation which will contribute to the maintenance and improvement of this agreement and promote effective cooperation between the institutions. This agreement is in perpetuity or until it is discontinued by either educational partner per the Termination provisions stated in the original agreement.




